MECHANISM OF CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

Curriculum committee: the Head of expertise group, head of department, and lecturers, manages the curriculum review. Curriculum committee responsibility is reviewing curriculum based on need analysis, developing, and evaluating curriculum. The curriculum development activities are carried out through the workshop phase of curriculum development at the study program level under the faculty as the steering committee. At the level of the study program, a course learning outcome is prepared to approved in the expertise group. At the discussion forum, learning outcomes were presented to be evaluated. The curriculum which has been evaluated, reviewed by Stakeholders. However, alumni can give suggestions about what they need. The approved curriculum is associated and developed according to the character of the BEC, and then applied by the university based on the Rector's Regulations to be implemented in the following next year. All lecturers are responsible for implementing the curriculum and evaluated.
